

On Monday 3rd April, our Year 3 students participated in a hands-on workshop facilitated by Mrs Bate and The Department of Fisheries. The students learnt all about sustainable fishing and how to maintain a healthy fishery. They learnt why we need to measure our catch and how scientists determine what size is acceptable to keep our fish species reproducing. The students enthusiastically explored sea artefacts, measured fish and even had a go at determining the age of fish by looking at fish ear bones. Many questions were asked and answered.























KINDY & P/P WELCOME AFTERNOON



HEALTHY CHOCOLATE & COCONUT BALLS

SCHOOL HOLIDAY SNACK **IDEAS**

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups medjool dates, seeds removed
- 1 cup almonds
- 1 cup hazelnuts
- 1/3 cup cacao
- 1 cup desiccated coconut

INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Add dates & nuts into a food processor, Process on high speed for 20 seconds.
- 2. Scrape down sides of bowl and add in cacao & coconut, process on full speed for 40-60 seconds or until mixture combines together (this may take a little while, Keep blending until it happens).
- 3. Roll into bite sized balls.
- 4. Store in the fridge for up to 1 week.

NOTES: These balls can be frozen and won't take too long to defrost.

EASY APPLE BITES

INGREDIENTS

- 2-4 tbsp nut or seed butter
- 1 apple (any kind you like), cored and sliced into rounds
- 2 tsp sesame seeds, sunflower seeds, and/or shredded coconut

INSTRUCTIONS

- Spread the nut butter on half the apple slices. Sprinkle with the seeds and/or coconut.
- Top with the remaining apple halves and eat right away. 2.

NOTES: 3 more ways to turn apple slices into a special snack:

- Layer with cheddar cheese.
- Dip into yogurt and then granola.
- Sprinkle with ground cinnamon.


