Whenever possible, walk with a friend or in a group. Never take short-cuts through isolated areas. Always be aware of one's surroundings. If possible, walk facing the on-coming traffic. Never get too close to cars that stop nearby. Always report any stranger danger concerns. Our staff continues to reinforce the above messages to the students in the class room and parents are encouraged to talk to their children about the importance of these messages. By using common-sense we can all work together to keep our children safe.

Throughout the year, there will be class displays and starry work in the office foyer. Whenever you are visiting the school, please "drop in" to see the great work. Presently, we have a variety of children's work on display.

Just a reminder that our staff car parks (Main Street) are **not** to be used for "dropping off" or "picking up" students. It was wonderful to see so many parents and students attend our parent/teacher/student interviews. We trust this experience provided a valuable opportunity for you to discuss your child's progress.


