The first game the students learnt was called Jumpinpin and was based on the way a mob who live off the coast of Stradbroke Island go spearfishing. They herd the fish into one spot and use teamwork to catch all the fish, then all share the catch. The second game was called Piloga and was based on the way two mobs settle disputes.

The students each had two tags which represented two 'lives.' Once both tags had been taken, the students had lost both their 'lives' and were out. The students had a lot of fun & were excited to learn some new team games.
