# **ALLERGY AWARE**

Balcatta Primary School is an Allergy Aware school. As some of our students have serious allergies to nuts, please do not send items that contain nuts or nut products to school. Be aware that many foods contain traces of nuts (e.g. Nutella type spreads, muesli bars, biscuits, peanut butter etc.).



Please alert the school to any allergies that your child/children may have on enrolment so we can implement the appropriate plan to support them. Your assistance in keeping all of our students safe is appreciated.

# **SCHOOL CAR PARKING**

Parents who pick up or set down children by car are asked to note the following:



- If using the "SOUTH car park (behind the Pre-primary Centre), enter via Alford Street and then left turn exit into Main Street.
- The verge area along Albert Street near the school oval can also be utilised.
- Park in Sylvia Street and cross Main Street using the pedestrian crossing attended by our crosswalk wardens.

**NOTE:** The **staff/visitors** car parks at the front of the school are for use by the staff and visitors **only** and are **NOT** to be used as a "drop off" or "pick up" area for students, particularly the car park outside the library.

Thank you for your anticipated support, which can only enhance the **safety** of our students.

# **SCHOOL CROSSING**



Our school crossing is monitored by our two wardens (Laurel and Mario) from 8.00 am to 9.00 am and 2.40 pm to 3.40 pm each school day.

IT IS MOST IMPORTANT THAT WHEN THE CROSSING IS OPERATING, EVERYONE MUST WAIT UNTIL THE WARDEN BLOWS THE WHISTLE TWICE BEFORE CROSSING. BICYCLES AND SCOOTERS ETC. MUST ALSO BE WALKED ACROSS.


