



### **MAGPIES BREEDING SEASON**

It's coming into breeding season for the Australian magpie and when they are feeding chicks, they can be quite frightening as they fiercely protect their nests.

### Tips to help you stay safe and avoid being attacked:

- The best way to avoid being attacked by a magpie is to avoid entering nesting areas while the young are in the nest.
- Wear sunglasses, a wide brimmed hat (especially children) or carry an umbrella.
- If you are swooped by a magpie, stay calm, walk away but do not run and avoid looking towards the swooping birds
- If a magpie attacks, avoid the area & take an alternative route for several weeks (chicks remain in nests for several weeks).





# **SPRING IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER**



Spring in the Noongar calendar for the South West of Western Australia is divided into two seasons: Djilba (August–September), known as "first spring," and Kambarang (October–November), known as "second spring".

Djilba is a transitional period with cold, clear days mixed with warmer, rainy, and windy days, while Kambarang brings longer dry periods and warmer weather as flowers like the <u>Moojar (Australian Christmas Tree)</u> bloom.
